Cosmos is a Second Early variety with high yields of uniform tubers. With a bright skin finish and good shape it also has good drought tolerance. It is well suited to organic production, and ideal for baking and chipping.

## Resistance

Good drought tolerance. Good resistance to Common Scab, Tuber Blight, bruising and splitting. Susceptible to Potato Cyst Nematode *Globodera Rostochiensis* and *Globodera Pallida*.
